

TOI- Risorse linguistico/terminologiche per la promozione dell'export e la disseminazione della creatività artigianale degli orafi

The project aims at assuring a proper, effective and tailored transfer of a methodological innovation able to detect, map, describe, certificate and transmit tacit competences characterizing the handicraft goldsmith sector.

The project's specific objectives are:

- 1. to produce a tested tool set comprising a database and a thesaurus able to map, describe and represent tacit competences in key-professional profiles of the goldsmith sector;
- 2. to assure an assessment and certification path for two families of professional profiles: the one of methodologists who are experts in the use of tacit competence mapping and description; the one of technicians / handicraftsmen involved in the production chain of the goldsmith sector. Both of them lack standard and certification in Romania as in most EU countries;
- 3. to design original curricula for the identified and described professional standards in order to assure a proper transmission and replicability of competences and know how. (i.e. contribution to employability at individual and sectoral level);
- 4. to realize a wide, segmented and multi-stakeholders valorization strategy able to assure cascade and long lasting effects of the project's results both at national and EU level.

The above specific objectives directly face one of the key-Romanian needs (i.e. strengthening and enriching the national professional standards) and one of the key-problem affecting the small handicraft business in Romania and in the rest of Europe as well: that is the possibility to represent rich and specific tacit competences - that is informal learning resulting from work-related activities which is not organized and structured - and in so doing assuring intergenerational transmission of key-competences, jobs and businesses.

The project's aim and objectives fully answer to the EU priority Transparency and recognition of competences and qualifications (LEO-TraInno-1) as it intends to support the development of national and sectoral qualification systems and frameworks incorporating a methodological approach coherent with the ECVET system and the European Qualifications Framework (EQF). In particular, T-Map project adopts a scheme related to learning outcomes (knowledge, skills and competence acquired in informal learning contexts, organised in units with procedure for assessment, transfer and learning accumulation).
